# AISA-Anji Onshore Campus Program

Adelaide Independent Schools Alliance (AISA) is a collaboration of 16 leading independent schools in South Australia. Representing over 900 years of educational excellence.

Adelaide International School (AIS) located in Adelaide, South Australia. AIS provides a quality learning pathway for International students who aspire to complete their primary and/or secondary school education in preparation for an enrolment at AISA schools and Universities.

Lanrun Angel Foreign Language Experimental School is located at the Town of Angel, Anji County, Zhejiang Province. It covers an area of 170 acres. With advanced facilities and philosophy, excellent teaching resources and environment, the school is a K-12 non-profit school.

Due to border restrictions brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic, students from China are very unlikely to travel to Australia at the start of 2021. Students who have nominated to enrol at an AISA school can now attend on-campus classes at the AISA-Anji Campus located in Zhejiang Province in China.



Our partner, AIS will provide a quality online program delivered to Chinese students resident on the AISA-Anji Campus. These courses will be suitable for upper-primary and secondary students prior to their arrival at their nominated AISA school in Adelaide.

Continuing students will receive their online program from their AISA school. These students will be able to study collaboratively, receive learning support from a team of highly qualified teachers, engage in co-curricular activities, and board together in supervised student accommodation at the AISA-Anji Campus.

AISA-Anji Onshore Campus program is suitable for the students who are in China and,

- are currently enrolled at AISA schools, but who have been prevented from returning to Australia and are currently studying online. Or,
- are newly recruited students, who have had their commencement date in Adelaide delayed and are planning to commence at an AISA school in the future.

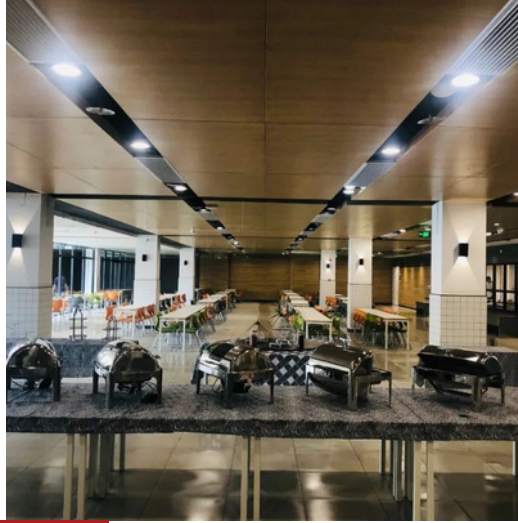

The boarding staff have a genuine interest in each student and their personal development. Our dynamic residential team aim to provide a safe environment in which every student has a happy and fulfilling year personally, spiritually and academically.

As pastoral carers, we are vitally concerned about the cultural, family, social and emotional wellbeing of every boarder.

Each class has a inhouse teacher and two assistance teachers to support our students while they study with us.

Inhouse teacher and assistant teachers work together to provide a positive learning environment to make students feel included connected, safe and respected.

Our on-campus teachers collaborate with Australian teachers to support student learning, safety and wellbeing. Termly reports will be provided to parents to keep track students' progress.

There is a compulsory study session on each night. Sessions are supervised by assistant teachers to ensure optimum study conditions.
